The GCCC will award a \$1,000.00 Scholarship to a high school graduating senior this year. The student must be either enrolled in West Genesee School District or be the child/grandchild of a Camillus Chamber Member Representative.

All applications for the scholarship must be received by the Chamber by April 30th. The Scholarship will be awarded in June at the GCCC Scholarship Award Breakfast (date TBD).

*Note: All sections of the application must be typewritten to be considered.

Each applicant should submit the following:

West Genesee High School Scholarship Application.

OR

A cover Sheet that contains the following information:

- -Applicant's name, address, home phone number and best contact numbers.
- -Parent/Guardians' names and best contact numbers.
- -High School attending.
- -If applicable, include the name of the Chamber Member Representative and relationship.

Applications should also include, in the following order:

- 1. A copy of the secondary school record, including an academic summary.
- 2. Certificate of acceptance from an accredited institute of higher learning.
- 3. Two references (no relatives)- teacher, coach, counselor, employer.
- 4. Completed community service worksheet (see attached).
- 5. 500 word, double spaced essay, answering one of the following two questions:
 - 1) What community event do you enjoy the most and why?
 - OR
 - 2) What new community event would you like to see started that would bring the community together?

All completed applications will be reviewed by the Scholarship Committee, and scored in three areas:

- 1) Written Essay
- 2) Community Participation
- 3) Academic Achievement
